New Students (Preschool-8th grade): the application fee is \$50.00 per student

For current choice students the application fee is \$0.00

During the **early enrollment** period the **application fee is \$25.00** per student or a family maximum of \$75.00 for returning students only (new students: \$50.00)

During the **open enrollment** period the **application fee is \$35.00** per student or a family maximum of \$100.00 for returning students only (new students: \$50.00)

Please note: Application fees are non-refundable

TUITION EXPLANATION

St. Mark Partner Tuition: Families that have chosen St. Mark Lutheran Church as their church home are charged the rate above as set by our Ministry Governing Board. These families also support the overall ministry of our congregation through their offering contributions.

Non WELS/ELS Tuition: St. Mark Lutheran School serves families that do not have a church home or have made other churches their church home. These families are charged a "non WELS/ELS tuition rate."

Sister WELS/ELS Tuition: St. Mark Lutheran School serves families that have made other area WELS/ELS churches their church home. Many area WELS/ELS churches offer tuition assistance to their church families. Families should contact their pastor or congregational leadership for tuition assistance information.

TUITION CONTRACT
